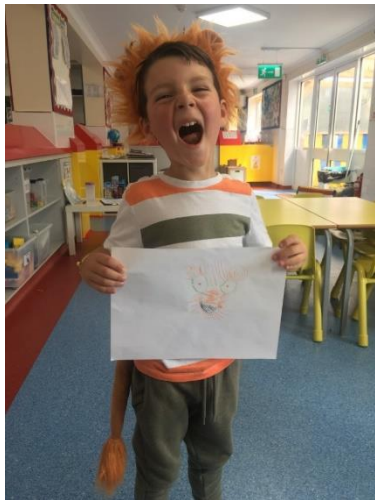
Topics:
