Dear parents and carers,

We hope that you all had a lovely Christmas and a happy new year to you all. We hope the Christmas break allowed you and your families to spend some quality time together.

Management would like to introduce uniforms for the children to prepare the older children for school and to be inclusive for the younger children. We also think it would be beneficial to avoid children's clothes becoming messy or stained whilst at nursery. We are looking for a potential supplier to make uniforms for us, however for the time being then we ask that your child wears a royal blue or white polo/t-shirt or sweatshirt with black trousers/bottoms.

Parents meetings will be taking place the week commencing 31st January. This gives you two weeks' notice to book an appointment if you would like one. The meeting would be with your child's key worker and would be no longer than 15 minutes long. Please email management with a date from the week of the 31st and a time between 9:30 am-11:30 am and 2:30 pm-4:30 pm.

Any time that you wish to change your child's sessions or go on a holiday, please ensure this is put in writing. For a change in session we must have at least one months' notice and any holiday notice needs to be as soon as you possibly can. Please remember that we are unable to swap sessions. This also applies to any changes with your contact information such as change of number of house address.

Many of you use Tapestry already however there are some parents who are yet to use the app. Please do so to upload things that you do at home with your child. It is also there to use as a form of communication with your child's key worker. If you have any questions for your child's key worker, you are able to ask this through the app. You may also ask about your child's development as well as informing the key worker of any changes to your child's routine. In addition to this, staff use the app to inform you of various things so please check your account regularly. If you have not set up an account or are unable to log in, please let a member of management know so that we can assist you.

As the children have recently returned from Christmas break, we will be using this time to find new interests and will be starting topics in February.

Please keep yourselves up to date with the events and don't forget to get your poet head's ready for the poet competition!
