We have found an organisation, that are accepting donations, that will be distributed in Poland where there are already refugee camps in place for the people fleeing Ukraine. We ask that parents, carers, family friends and anyone you might know takes place in our collection.

The items that are able to be donated are as follows: first aid kits, wound dressings, anti-flu remedies, painkillers, rich in protein snacks, canned food, bread sticks, tea, sugar, coffee, water, batteries, torches, formula milk, porridge, nappies, wipes, dummies, bottles, small toys, sanitary products, anti-bac gels, thermal cups, toothbrushes, shampoo, shower gels, blankets, sleeping bags, underwear, socks, t-shirts and any other clothes items. If you could have these items to us as soon as possible, so that we can begin transferring them to their destination, that would be great. We and the people of Ukraine will be grateful for anything that you have to offer, no matter how small.

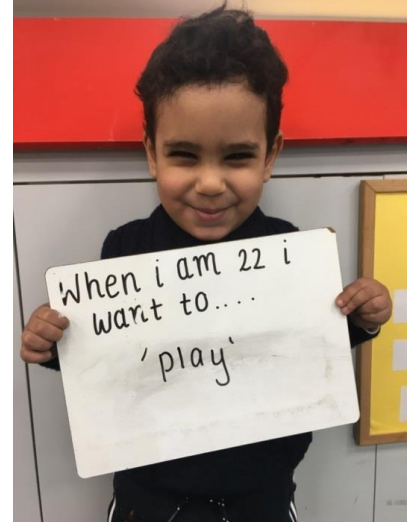
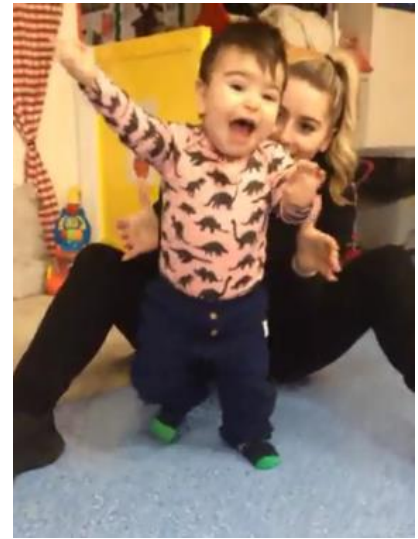
